
Dear Patients,

Practice Updates

Health Focus of the Month: Summer Heat Safety

With rising temperatures, remember to: Stay hydrated – aim for 6–8 glasses of water daily. Avoid direct sun during peak hours (11 am–3 pm). Check on elderly neighbours and relatives. Wear sunscreen with SPF 30 or higher. If you experience dizziness, headaches, or confusion in the heat, seek medical advice promptly.



Treatment from a pharmacist

Pharmacists can suggest treatments that do not need a prescription for a range of conditions.

Most pharmacies can also offer prescription medicine for some conditions, without you needing to see a GP or make an appointment. This is called Pharmacy First.

Conditions they can offer prescription medicine for are:

- impetigo (aged 1 year and over)
- infected insect bites (aged 1 year and over)
- earache (aged 1 to 17 years)
- sore throat (aged 5 years and over)
- sinusitis (aged 12 years and over)
- urinary tract infections (UTIs) (women aged 16 to 64 years)
- shingles (aged 18 years and over)

If you are not within these age ranges, a pharmacist can still offer advice and support decisions about selfcare treatment with over-the-counter medicines, but you may need to see a GP for treatment.

If you go to a pharmacy with one of these conditions, the pharmacist will offer you advice, treatment or refer you to a GP or other health professional if

needed. They will also update your GP health record, but your information will not be shared with anyone else.
